#### T-BALL FUN DAY

T-Ball Fun Day takes place on Saturday, June 15th at Frank Ryan park (all three diamonds). Players will take to the field for about 50 minutes and at the end of the game, they will receive medals.

We will have fun activities and a charity BBQ which will run from approx. 11:00am - 2:30pm. Instead of charging for food/drinks, we will be collecting cash donations/pay-what-you-can

contributions. All money we collect will be donated to the Britannia Woods Food Pantry. OWLL will cover the cost of the food. We ask that parents bring cash since we won't have any way to process credit cards. Coaches will share the schedule closer to the date.



## Summer ball!!

While it seems like the spring season has just started, we are already halfway through the season, and registration for co-ed summer ball is opening up! Look for general registration for players in t-ball, rookie, minor, major, junior, and senior to open in early to mid June (priority given to spring ball players). For minor and major players, the sign up for mandatory evaluations is open now. Please <u>complete this form</u> to sign up. Minor and major evaluations will take place on June 7<sup>th</sup> at Frank Ryan North.

Our ability to offer these summer programs depends on parent volunteers to coach and assist our coaches at all levels. IMPORTANT: If we don't have volunteers, we will not be able to offer teams at all ages. If you are available for summer, please register as a coach or contact Mike McLean.

Co-ed summer ball is generally considered to be more competitive than spring, however, with 3 levels in most divisions, there are still opportunities for all skill levels to participate. Our summer season, for most age groups, starts after Canada Day and continues until late August. For the most part, our summer teams interlock with other Little Leagues within the City of Ottawa and surrounding areas. This year in addition to interlock (against teams across the city), we will be offering house (local diamonds only, against other OWLL teams) and at rookie and minor/major (combined). The girls season for rookie – junior/senior continues until late July, and GOBL runs through to August.

Player placement on teams begins with the top-tier team, the all-star team, and cascades downward from there. The next level offered is placement on one Canadian (A) level team, followed by one or more national (B) level teams. There are 12 spots available on the all-star team. It is a tournament team and requires a significantly greater time and travel commitment than A or B. Like spring ball, the Canadian and national teams usually have 13-14 players.

The sort outs for the all-star teams and some Canadian level teams took place in late May. If players opted not to try out or were not selected for these teams but wish to play summer ball, there will be another round of try-outs <u>in early to mid June</u>. These will determine placement on the remaining Canadian or national/house teams.

NOTE: Players will receive a summer hat and dry fit (team uniform) with their registration so please make sure to update shirt sizes in your registration.
